


CHURCH MEETINGS ARE BRILLIANT

You may have noticed the 'for sale' sign on MHCS (Manna House Counselling Service) at 73 St Giles Street. No, MHCS is *NOT* closing down but the building is no longer as suitable as it once was, especially since the closure of their bookshop across the road from it.

Also, there is quite a lot of money 'tied up' in the bricks and mortar. The trustees, therefore, after much prayerful consideration, decided to put the property on the market and look for premises more suitable for the counselling, counsellor training and wellbeing course activities.

Sadly for some of us, it means that the parking spaces at the rear of the building will not be available to us on Sundays after the building is sold.
