

These pledge forms will be available in church on Sunday 15th and 22nd September and will only be read by Duncan Halliday, our treasurer, who will be able to reconcile the pledge with the gift coming in. Please continue to pray.

Please note: Further road closures are expected on Sun 15th September around town for the <u>running event</u>. This may affect some of you as you travel to St Giles for the morning or evening service so please allow plenty of time. I understand from the organisers that the town centre is closed for the duration of the event. Bedford Road and Cheyne Walk/York Road are open so access to church is possible this way.
