Please do start thinking about neighbours, friends and family members you could invite.




Christmas Orchestra and Choir

If this is something that you might be able to join in with then please let <u>David Lidbetter or Stephen</u> Hewitson know.


Practices will be taking place in the run up to Christmas, and times of these will be available soon.
