

It's Panto Time! Our very own Alyth and Tony will be performing in Aladdin, The True Story.



Prayers of Love and Faith

Many will be aware of the suite of prayers called Prayers of Love and Faith, intended to be used to bless loving and stable same-sex relationships, was commended for use by the House of Bishops in December 2023. At the last APCM in May 2024, I was asked what my and St Giles' view on this topic is. Consequently, we have had conversations amongst the Exec (PCC Standing Committee) and the wider PCC, and we have decided on a process for how we will engage with this topic as a church. 
